**GOOD NEIGHBOR FUND
SMALL BUSINESS GRANT APPLICATION**

In response to the Covid-19 pandemic, UACF's Good Neighbor Fund now extends to **qualifying small businesses** that have been affected by the crisis. The new rules are valid to October 17, 2020. **UA-based small businesses may apply for a one-time grant of up to \$3,500.** These grants do not require repayment.

Requirements for a one-time Good Neighbor Fund (GNF) Small Business Grant

The applicant business must:

- Be based in the city of Upper Arlington, Ohio.
- Demonstrate an urgent need due to hardship created by the Covid-19 crisis. (Please describe it below.)
- Provide a copy of the bill that would be covered by the GNF Small Business Grant.
- Have not received Good Neighbor Fund grant assistance in the past.

Recommended, but not required:

- Show proof of requesting three-month rent deferral per Governor DeWine's order.
- Provide a copy of your PPP application (if completed) and your banker's name and contact information.

Please note: UACF doesn't not provide cash. This grant will cover a specific expense, such as a rent or insurance payment.
