2026 Scholarship Guidelines

Scholarship Background

The scholarship was created by members at Scioto Country Club as a way to show appreciation for Club team members and support them as they continue their education.

Eligibility Criteria

- Candidates must be a Scioto Country Club team member; either an employee in good standing who has been employed for more than six months, or any seasonal staff member who has commenced their second term of service, or an independent contractor who has completed at least six months of consecutive service, or a caddie who has completed at least 20 loops or the spouse, child, or grandchild of an eligible employee.
- Candidates must attend or plan to pursue a two- or four-year degree program; a career or technical program, a master's degree program, either full- or part-time; or a private school.
- Candidates must attend a school in the U.S.

Selection Criteria

- 34% Special Circumstance
- 33% Educational Pursuit Consistent with the Purpose of the Fund
- 33% Term of Service

Selection Committee

- Representative, Scioto Country Club
- Representative, Scioto Country Club
- Representative, Scioto Country Club
- Community Representative Designated by the Foundation

Award Amount

Minimum \$500

Renewal

The scholarship is not renewable, but eligible recipients are encouraged to reapply.

Payment Distribution

All awards are paid directly to the educational institution.

The scholarship may be used for any educational expenses.

Application Requirements

Individual Application

- Employment Information
- Essay: why did you choose your major or course of study, and what would receiving a scholarship mean to you.
- Optional Essay: Describe any special circumstances that impact your schooling or ability to pay for school.
- Resume
- Letter of Recommendation

Timeline

Deadline to apply: July 15, 2026; Decision to applicant by: August 10, 2026

Application and Award Process

- Scioto Country Club notifies eligible team members of the availability of the scholarship each year.
- Candidates complete the online application by the deadline.
- After the deadline, the Foundation reviews complete applications for eligibility.
- A spreadsheet of the candidates is sent to an HR contact at Scioto Country Club to verify eligibility.
- The Foundation sets up the online review.
- The Foundation will convene the selection committee.
- After selection, the Foundation notifies those who did not receive the scholarship.
- The Foundation sends award letters to recipients that explain the payment request process and include the proof of enrollment form.
- Once proof of enrollment has been received by the Foundation, a check will be sent to the recipient's educational institution.
